Rules and Regulations

- 1. All project guidelines and rubrics can be found in the P3982: 4-H Poultry Chain Project Guide and the P3934: 4-H Poultry Chain Project Record Book.
- 2. Cloverbud, Junior, and Senior 4-H Participants are allowed to compete at the County Level.
- 3. Junior and Senior 4-H Participants ONLY are allowed to compete at the State Level.
- 4. There are two categories- Meat and Layer.
 - A participant may enter only one of the two categories.
 - See the list of acceptable breeds in the P3982 Project Guide.
- 5. There are two sections within the State Show. Each participant will be judged on each.
 - Live Birds
 - Record Book
 - See P3934 Record Book Guide for rubrics on each.
- 6. An optional Showmanship Category is also available.

Awards

There are four categories (Junior Meat, Junior Layer, Senior Meat, and Senior Layer). A total of 28 placings across the four categories will be awarded, including monetary award amounts and a banner or ribbon.

Four placings are awarded across the two age divisions (Junior and Senior). Winners will receive the monetary amount, banner, and buckle.
